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SPECIFICS OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORTS NORMATIVE
AND LEGAL REGULATION IN UKRAINE

In a context of decisive steps towards the European Union integration and the war against Russia, our country is trying to create a comprehensive program of social and economic development, to reform economics, to provide necessary management mechanisms and, also, to form an adequate fiscal system. The sphere of physical training and sports is divided into two major segments: professional sports and mass physical training and sports.

Central and regional public authorities are involved in professional sports involve and local governments are especially engaged in mass physical training and sports. Here we can notice that in many cities professional sports teams and individual athletes are supported with expenses of local budgets and sponsorship.

Under the Constitution, the citizens of Ukraine have the right to engage in physical training and sport, irrespective of their origin, social or material status, race and nationality, sex, education, religion, occupation, place of residence and other circumstances. In accordance with the procedure established by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine, the state guarantees free and preferential physical and health recreation events for children, including: orphans and children left without parental care, children affected by the Chernobyl disaster, children from large and poor families, disabled children and others. Alose, the state creates the necessary conditions for legal protection of citizens' interests in the field of physical training and sports; develops sports industry and infrastructure, encourages the desire of citizens to strengthen their health, to lead a healthy life.

The priorities of national policy were embodied in relevant laws and regulatory legal acts: laws, Presidential decrees and decisions of the Verkhovna Rada and the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine, orders and regulatory-guidance documents.

Issues concerning management of the sphere of physical training and sports, as well as its regulation are considered in works of the following domestic scholars: O. Alikova, S. Vavreniuk, V. Huzar, Y. Dovhenkiy, M. Dutchak, V.Zhukova, V. Zatytkina, V. Kudelko, M. Oliynyk, V. Platonov, I. Rybach, M. Trubina, Y. Shkhrebtiiy and others. Analysis of the modern domestic legal publications suggests the in sufficiency of both scientific papers in the

level of monographs and scientific articles dedicated to the problems of regulation of relations in the field of physical training and sports.

Systematic analysis of more than 170 regulatory legal acts in the field of physical training and sports, adopted during the years of independence of Ukraine gives grounds to state that the government efforts are focused on the improvement of mechanisms of legal, scientific, institutional, medical and other types of support for the industry and making them consistent with sociopolitical and economic facts of the country.

Government bodies deal with the following tasks: 1) development of children and youth sports; 2) development of physical training and sports among working-age population; 3) physical and sports education of the aged and disabled people; 4) creation of sports infrastructure for the development of mass sports in educational institutions as well as according to the place of residence; 5) construction of sporting facilities for the development of sports of the highest achievements on major sports; 6) providing of trainings, retrainings and advanced trainings of specialists in physical training and sports; 7) increasing the interest of different categories of citizens in physical training and sport by promoting physical culture, sports and healthy lifestyles; 8) improvement of legal framework of physical culture and sports; 9) creation of conditions for development of sports higher achievements, preparation of reserve.

We can say that at the moment the issue of legislation improvement in the branch of physical training and sports is in the background mode in Ukraine due to various circumstances. In particular, the issues on professional sports have rather poor legislative regulation.
